This was hosted by Scottish Fire and Rescue to engage with people in the area who educate their children at home. The event is run to give children that are home educated access to sessions with emergency services as children within schools get with planned visits.

Within the event, the children went round various interactive stations including:

- Basic First Aid and the various equipment used.
- Phonetic alphabet and radio work
- Rope Tying
- Emergency Kit Planning

They were also able to speak with both Fire Service and Police about their roles and were shown around the vehicles.

HMP Perth Operation

On Tuesday 24th March, Police Scotland and the Scottish Prison Service worked in partnership to carry out a coordinated operation aimed at preventing the introduction of controlled substances into HMP Perth. The operation involved enhanced security checks and proactive engagement with visitors to disrupt attempts to smuggle drugs into the establishment.

As a result of the operation, multiple visitors were searched, one individual was refused entry to the premises, one individual was arrested for a drug related offence, and several vehicles were stopped to check driving documentation.

Police Scotland and the Scottish Prison Service remain committed to working together to prevent the supply of drugs into prisons and to ensure the safety and security of staff, prisoners and visitors.



Local News and Updates

A 28-year-old man was arrested and charged in connection with a serious assault in Perth and has now been charged with attempted murder.

Officers were called to a report of a woman injured in Dunkeld Road, Perth around 2:45pm, Monday 30th March. Emergency services attended and the woman was taken to hospital.

The arrested male was remanded on appearing at Perth Sheriff Court.

Between Tuesday 17th and Saturday 21st March, a property was broken in to in Mavisbank, Kinross. A Volkswagen T-Roc was stolen.

The vehicle was later recovered in Hunterfield Road, Gorebridge. Enquiries are ongoing.

A 24-year-old man was arrested for smashing a window, damaging a vehicle and 2 CCTV cameras in Wallace Court, Perth on Tuesday 24th March.

About 11:55am, Saturday 21st March, 2 males were captured on CCTV using bolt cutters to cut the chain securing a charcoal grey Cube bike to a rack in York Place, Perth.

The males pushed the bike off in the direction of New Row. One male was wearing all black clothing and the other was wearing a grey hooded top, underneath a black jacket and grey trousers.

A 38-year-old man has been arrested and charged with attempted murder in connection to an incident in McCallum Court, Perth on Saturday 28th March.

Emergency services were called to a report of an injured male, he was conveyed to hospital. The arrested male was remanded in custody after appearing at Perth Sheriff Court on Monday 30th March.

Overnight on Monday 23rd March, a quantity of tools were stolen during a break in to a property undergoing renovation on the outskirts of Bendochy, between Blairgowrie and Coupar Angus.

2 men aged 41 and 27, were arrested for assault and robbery after officers were called to a report of an injured male in Drumhar Court, Perth on Tuesday 24th March.

Both arrested men were remanded in custody.

About 7:30am, Wednesday 25th March, entry was forced to property in Addison Terrace, Crieff and a quantity of cash stolen from within. 2 males wearing dark clothing with hoods up were seen in the area at the material time.

2 men aged 51 and 37 were arrested for housebreaking with intent to steal due to being found in a property in Knockard Place, Pitlochry having forced entry on Monday 27th March.

A 45-year-old man was arrested for a number of offences, including drink driving, driving without insurance and possession of a class B drug in Feus Road, Perth on Friday 24th March.
